

GUIDELINES FOR PRESENTING DIGITAL POSTERS AT THE XXXII ISSCT CONGRESS AND CENTENNIAL 2025

To ensure the quality and graphic consistency of the digital posters presented at the XXXII ISSCT Congress and Centenary 2025, authors must comply with the following guidelines for their presentation:

1. Official Template for Presenting Digital Posters

- The Congress Organizing Committee provides a PowerPoint template for presenting digital posters. This template must be designed as an infographic, using elements such as graphs, images, and/or icons.
- This template includes established margins and branding elements that should not be modified.
- The use of this template is mandatory to ensure correct display on the screens where the poster will be projected.
- The document must be sent as a PowerPoint file, without any blocked elements, with the name of the first author followed by the abbreviated title of the poster (Example: "Julio Calpa_Eficiencia_Cana.pptx"). To the email: capacitacion@tecnicana.org with the subject: Poster_author's name (Example: Julio Calpa)_abbreviated title of the poster (Eficiencia_Caña).
- Add high-resolution images and graphics to ensure correct viewing from a distance.

2. Guidelines for the Creation of Digital Posters:

2.1 Typography:

- Font: Use a universal font to avoid compatibility issues: Arial
- Minimum font size:



Title: between 60 and 72 pt, bold.Subtitles: 36-44 pt, bold if desired.

o General text: 24–28 pt.

· Avoid using decorative or handwritten fonts.

2.2 Design and Layout:

- Be careful not to exceed the margin provided by the text box.
- The design should be **well-distributed**, avoiding text saturation.
- Use **light or high-contrast** backgrounds for easy reading.
- Include **institutional logos** where indicated in the template.

2.3 Images and Graphics:

- All images and photographs must be high-resolution (minimum 150 dpi).
- Avoid pixelated or distorted images.
- Graphs must have legible labels and clearly marked axes.
- Ensure that the colors used have good contrast.

2.4 Recommended Content:

- Title of the paper.
- Authors and logo.
- Introduction, abstracts, objectives, methodology, results, and conclusions in summary form.
- Relevant graphs, tables, or images.

2.5 Final Considerations:

- We recommend running a proofread to verify readability.
- The poster must be written in **English**, the official language of the Conference.



3. Poster Submission

- Submission format: PowerPoint document and image, attached to the email.
- Digital posters must be submitted in their final version by August 11, 2025.
- Authors must be present at their posters during the times indicated in the program. If desired, authors may request a brochure as a complement to their presentation.

Note: The agenda with poster presentation times will be provided in advance.

- If the lead poster author cannot attend, they must designate one of the co-authors to act on their behalf.
- Poster location: Second floor hall at the Valle del Pacifico Events Center, Cali, Colombia.

IMPORTANT:

- Do not modify the dimensions of the template attached to this release.
- Do not overload the poster with information; it should be self-explanatory and convey the essence of your message. Text should be short and concise.
- Commercial promotion is not permitted in the presentations, nor is commercial mention by the authors.

Please follow these guidelines to ensure a high-quality and visually appealing presentation.
